Rationale & Aims

DfE research estimates that in the first half term of Autumn 2020, pupils in years 3-9 were 1.6 – 2 months behind on their reading and 3.2 months behind on their maths. There is evidence to suggest that young people's mental health has also suffered as a result of extensive periods of lockdown and of isolation.

The summer school's academic focus has the aim of making up for some missed education as the EEF finds that on average, pupils attending a summer school can make up to 2 months' additional progress. However, we hope to provide a broader benefit with pupils who attend receiving help with the period of transition to secondary school and improved cultural capital.

AIMS:

- To support an identified cohort of pupils in the social transition from primary to secondary school
- To build pupils' confidence academically as well as socially
- To demonstrate to the pupils the importance of community and working together
- To provide an engaging experience and introduce pupils to new knowledge and experiences
- To identify and begin to close literacy and numeracy gaps to ensure a good start to their secondary school career
